

Terms of Reference

1. Promote and facilitate cooperation between staff, students and management in the implementation of OHS policy, procedures, guidelines and programs across the faculty
2. Ensure that a prompt, uniform approach, based on best practice and continuous improvement, is adopted by the faculty and all its operations, in all matters of OHS
3. Monitor and continuously improve faculty compliance with OHS legislation, standards, codes of practice, policy and procedures
4. Review the OHS performance of the faculty and its centres to ensure that all areas consistently achieve a high standard
5. Co-ordinate the development and implementation of planning processes that are consistent and aligned with the university's broader strategic planning in order to ensure a proactive approach to OHS management across the university and all its operations
6. Promote OHS awareness and appropriate behavioural and cultural change of staff and students throughout the faculty
7. To identify issues and develop and implement strategies in relation to social inclusion in the faculty, in line with the University's Social Inclusion Strategy.
